

PRIVACY POLICY ON THE PROCESSING OF THE PERSONAL DATA OF THE WEBSITE USERS

This statement provides the following information on the processing of personal data collected as a result of interaction with the website starting from the URL [http https://www.tuvaustraiitalia.com](http://https://www.tuvaustraiitalia.com).

In case the user exit from the domain <https://www.tuvaustraiitalia.com/> and visit other websites whose links can also be shown in the web pages published on the website <https://www.tuvaustraiitalia.com>, reference should be made to the information on the protection of personal data of the aforementioned websites.

Data controller and contact details

The data controller is TÜV AUSTRIA ITALIA - BLU SOLUTIONS S.R.L. headquartered in MONTE ROBERTO (AN), Via del Commercio, 6/A - VAT 02217380423.

Type of personal data processed

The data controller processes the non-sensitive personal data as detailed in the paragraphs below.

The user who visits the website and intends to receive information and contents to his/her own contacts, is asked to write his/her name and surname, e-mail address and telephone number.

Legal basis of the processing

Only prior to specific and distinct consent (Article 7 of the GDPR), personal data, e-mails and telephone numbers provided by the user may be used for the purpose of sending via e-mail documents, videos, images, audio.

If the user does not intend to communicate the personal data as detailed in the sentence above, it is not possible to send via e-mail the material the user requested.

Assuming that it is in his/her interest, the user may subsequently be contacted for direct marketing purposes, namely send newsletters, commercial communications and/or advertising material on products or services offered by the data controller and similar to those previously requested.

Concerning the data provided by the data subject, he/she is responsible for the truthfulness of these data and for the fact that there are in them no elements having a direct or indirect or subliminal nature or advertising purpose or that could cause injury to third parties' personal or property rights.

The Data Controller will process personal data for the time necessary to fulfill the abovementioned purposes and in any case for no more than 2 years starting from the collection of data for marketing purposes.

Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data

With no need of an express consent, the Data Controller may communicate data to Supervisory Bodies, Judicial Authorities, insurance companies for the provision of insurance services, as well as to those subjects to whom the communication of these data is mandatory by law.

These subjects will process data as independent data controllers.

Data transfer and disclosure

There is no intention of the data controller to transfer personal data to a third country (i.e. non-EU) or to an international organization, personal data are processed only within Member States of the European Union. The personal data as referred to in this statement will in no case be transferred or sold to third parties.

Rights of the data subject

The data subject has the rights as referred to in art. 15 GDPR and precisely the rights of:

- i. obtaining confirmation of the existence or not of personal data concerning him/her, even if not yet registered, and their communication in an intelligible form;
- ii. obtaining information on: a) the origin of personal data; b) the purposes and methods of the processing; c) the logic applied in case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic means; d) the identifying details of the data controller, the data processors and the designated representative pursuant to art. 3, paragraph 1, GDPR; e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated or who may become aware of it as designated representative in the territory of the State, managers or processors;
- iii. obtaining: a) the updating, editing or, when interested, integration of data; b) the erasure, anonymization or blocking of data processed unlawfully, including data whose storage is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed; c) proof that the activities listed in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or transferred, except in the case where such fulfillment proves to be impossible or involves a use of means manifestly disproportionate compared to the protected right;
- iv. to object, in whole or in part: a) for legitimate reasons, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection; b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising or direct sales material or for carrying out market research or commercial communication, through the use of automated call systems without the intervention of an operator, by email and/or through traditional marketing methods, by telephone and/or paper mail. It should be noted that the right to object of the data subject, detailed in point b) above, to direct marketing purposes through automated methods extends to traditional ones and that in any case the possibility remains for the data subject to exercise the right to object even only partially.

Therefore, the data subject can decide to receive only communications by traditional means namely only automated communications or none of both types of communication.

At any time he/she can use the right to revoke the authorization for the processing of audiovisual and photographic material.

Where applicable, the data subject also have the rights as referred to in Articles 16-21 GDPR (Right of rectification, right to be forgotten, right of restriction of processing, right of data portability, right to object), as well as the right of complaint to the Guarantor Authority.

There are no automated decision-making or profiling processes.
